Diversity in Education: Developing Intercultural and Communication Skills

1 Week /5 Training Days

TARGET AUDIENCE

This course is for teachers and educators who wish to develop their skills for participating in internationalisation activities at home (receiving foreign students and teachers, teaching students from diverse cultural backgrounds) and abroad (international exchanges and projects).

COURSE SUMMARY

Internationalisation covers a wide range of contexts: receiving students from abroad, sending students abroad, teacher exchange programmes, international projects, as well as dealing with cultural diversity in the home classroom. This course is aimed at teachers and educators who would like to gain a better understanding of and develop skills for working with diversity in a range of educational contexts. The objectives of this course are to raise awareness of the influences of diversity on behaviour, especially communication, coming from both culture and personality; and also to explore how to integrate this type of training into classroom activities for both staff and students.

PREPARATION

Once registered participants on this course programme will receive:

A pre-course questionnaire which will enable trainers to learn about the participants' teaching backgrounds and to assess their exact needs Information about the Europass Mobility Certificate

A recommended reading list to prepare participants for various aspects of the course

OBJECTIVES

By the end of the course participants will develop:

- an understanding of the challenges of working with diversity
- an awareness of culture and its impact on behaviour, especially communication
- an awareness of different patterns of culturally-influenced behaviour
- an awareness of personality and its impact on behaviour, especially communication
- an awareness of different patterns of personality-influenced behaviour
- soft skills, especially in terms of communication, for working effectively in diverse teams and on international projects
- skills for working with culturally diverse groups
- a plan for integrating intercultural and interpersonal training into their classrooms

METHODOLOGY

This course has three main components:

- 1. inputs about culture and intercultural competences; and about personality and interpersonal competences, including soft skills
- 2. practice activities, including discussion, role plays and decision-making activities, to explore the topics and developskills
- 3. a final activity in which the course participants will present their plans for integrating the course content into their organisation

FOLLOW UP

- The course will end with an evaluation session where participants will be asked to reflect upon the value of the knowledge gained on the course and its usefulness to them
- They will also be encouraged to develop their own Personal Development Action Plan at the end of the course
